- Entry Fees \$15 per class, \$20 per medal class
- All riders will be charged a \$10 EMT/insurance fee
- There is a Grounds Fee of \$15/per entry. This fee is waived if you are paying for stabling at the show.
- Stabling is available at all shows. Please contact the host stable for information.
- A trophy and 8 ribbons will be awarded in each class
- Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in each Hunter division
- Points are counted 1st–6th places in classes
- One ring for most classes
- Shorts stirrup starts at 1:00 pm in Ring 2
- Warm-up will run all day as a ticketed class ahead of first class in each division (not to be judged)
- Points:

1st – 10 points	4th – 2 points
2nd – 6 points	5th – 1 point
3rd – 4 points	6th – 1/2 point
- Negative 2009-2010 Coggins is required

DIRECTIONS for ESRAS & NWNY Horse Shows

LEHMAN FARM

From the East on Route 90: Exit 46, Take Rte. 253 (Lehigh Station Rd.) East. Turn right (south) onto Rte. 65 (Clover St.) Take first left on Canfield Rd. (into Mendon Ponds Park. Next left is Wilmarth Rd.. Farm is at end of road on right.

HUNTINGTON MEADOW STABLES

From the East on Route 90: Exit 43 at Manchester. Go left off exit onto Rte. 21 North to Palmyra. Turn left onto Rte. 31 Macedon. At Mobil Chemical Plant, turn right onto Rte. 350 and continue on 350 to 441. Turn right onto Salt Road. Stables are on the right, approximately four miles from Rte. 441

From the West on Rte. 90: Exit at LeRoy, Take Rte. 490 to Rte 590. Take 2nd exit (Browncroft Blvd. – Rte. 286) Turn right off exit onto 286. After the intersection of 286 and 250, continue on 286 to Salt Road. Turn left. Stable on right approximately one mile after Plank Road intersection.

CANALSIDE

From the West: Exit Rte 490 at Rte 441 traveling east. Approximately 4.8 miles after crossing Rte. 250 turn right onto West Walworth Rd.. Follow for 1.7 miles and farm will be on the left.

From the South: Take Rte.. 31 east heading out of Fairport. Turn left onto Wayneport Rd.. , and take to the end, turning right onto Quaker. At the 3-way stop, turn left onto West Walworth Rd.. Follow West Walworth or 1.7 miles and the farm will be on the right.

WAY FARM

From the East on Interstate 90: Exit 43 at Manchester Go left off exit onto Rte. 21 North to Palmyra. Turn left onto Rte. 31 to Macedon. At the Mobil Chemical Plant turn onto Rte 350 and continue to Rte 350 to Rte 441. Go 5-6 miles to Harris Rd., turn right. Way Farm is on the left approximately .3 miles from the corner.

From the West on Interstate 90: Exit 47 at LeRoy, Take Rte. 490 to Rte. 590 North. Take 2nd exit (Rte. 286/Browncroft Blvd.). Turn right off exit onto Rte. 286. After intersection of 286 and 250, Harris Rd. is the first right Stable on the right , about 2 miles.

NWNY

NOVICE ADULT HUNTERS

To be ridden by a novice rider. This division is designed for the inexperienced rider. A novice rider is one who has not won 3 ribbons at a recognized show. To be judged on the performance of the horse at a walk, trot, and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'3". May not cross-enter Adult Amateur Hunter.

- 33-34. Novice Adult Hunter Over Fences

SPECIAL HUNTERS

Opens to all horses and riders. To be judged on the performance of the rider at a walk, trot and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'6".

- 35. Special Hunter Under Saddle
- 36-37. Special Hunter Over Fences

WARM-UP HUNTERS

Ticketed Warm-Up – \$10 per round. Open all day before first class of division

LEAD-LINE

Riders may not cross-enter any other division for the weekend.

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTERS

Open to riders 12 years and under. Fences are cross rails. Riders may trot or canter the course. Riders can only cross-enter Low-and-Slow and Hack divisions. (*Only for true beginners*)

- 39. Short Stirrup Under Saddle
- 40-41. Short Stirrup Over Fences

LOW-AND-SLOW HUNTERS

Open to riders of any age. Fences not to exceed 1'. Riders are expected to canter the course. Riders can only cross-enter Short Stirrup and Hack divisions. (*Only for true beginners*)

CHILDREN'S EQUITATION

Open to riders 18 years and under, eligible for the Children's Hunter division. To be judged on the performance of the rider at a walk, trot and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'6". Junior division exhibitors may not cross-enter.

1. Children's Equitation Walk, Trot, Canter
2. Children's Equitation Over Fences

JUNIOR EQUITATION

Opens to riders 18 year and under, entered in the Junior Hunter division. To be judged on the performance of the rider at a walk, trot and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 3'.

ADULT AMATEUR EQUITATION

Open to all amateur riders no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors. To be judged on the performance of the rider at a walk, trot and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 3'.

6. Adult Amateur Equitation Over Fences

NOVICE ADULT EQUITATION

Open to all Novice riders no longer eligible to compete as novice children exhibitors. To be judged on the performance of the rider at a walk, trot, and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'3". May not cross-enter Adult Amateur equitation.

NOVICE CHILDREN'S EQUITATION

Open to all novice riders 17 years and under eligible for Novice Children's Hunter division. To be judged on the performance of the rider at a walk, trot and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'3". May not cross-enter Children's Equitation. Division may be combined if less than 20 riders combined.

N.W.N.Y MEDALS

Horses are to be shown over a course of no fewer than 8 obstacles, which must include an oxer and two changes of direction. Test on course, test 1–10. Children's fences not to exceed 2'6". Juniors and Adult Amateurs not to exceed 2'9".

PONY HUNTERS

Open to ponies not exceeding 14.2 hands in height. Pony's performance to be judged at a walk, trot and canter, or over a course of fences. Section A at 2'; Section B at 2'6". Both sections to be judged as one class. If there is a minimum of ten entries, with at least six in one section, there will be a split. Ponies may enter either section but must remain consistent throughout the show. Ponies may cross-enter into Children's classes. Management reserves the right to measure any pony at any given show.

CHILDREN'S HUNTERS

Open to riders 18 years and under. To be judged on the performance of the horse at a walk, trot and canter or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'6". May not cross-enter Junior division.

17. Children's Hunter Under Saddle
- 18-19. Children's Hunter Over Fences

JUNIOR HUNTERS

Open to riders 18 years and under. To be judged on the performance of the horse at a work, trot and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'9". May not cross-enter Children's division.

20. Junior Hunter Under Saddle
- 21-22. Junior Hunter Over Fences

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTERS

Open to amateur riders who are no longer eligible to compete as juniors. To be judged on the performance of the horse at a walk, trot and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'9". Adult Amateur Hunter Classes 24 & 25 will run at two heights, 2'6" and 2'9". Please advise the starter which height you will ride in. Once the fences are changed they will not be adjusted again. Classes will be pinned as one.

23. Adult Amateur Hunter Under Saddle

LOW HUNTERS

Open to all riders and horses. To be judged on the performance of the horse at a walk, trot and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'9".

NOVICE CHILDREN'S HUNTERS

To be ridden by a novice rider. This division is designed for the inexperienced rider. A novice rider is one who has not won 3 blue ribbons at a recognized horse show. To be judged on the performance of the horse at a walk, trot, and canter, or over a course of fences not to exceed 2'3". The class will be split by age group: 12 and under and 13-17 (Rider's age as of Dec 1, 2010). May not cross-enter into Children's Hunters.
